Scholarship Information:

1. Students must be planning to major in the subjects of history, English or the foreign languages.
 2. Scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:
 - 50% academic
 - 25% extracurricular involvement, including participation in service and/or academic organizations
 - 25% essays
 3. All scholarship monies will be paid directly to the college or university in which the recipient enrolls.
 4. Applications may be obtained by going to www.texrenfest.com. Follow the links to the New Application and print out the on-line information and application. All applications, recommendation letters, and transcripts **must** be returned to the festival office **by April 1, 2019.** Only **completed** applications will be considered (all essays, recommendations and official transcripts must be included).
 5. Recipients will be announced May 1, 2019.
 6. The application is confidential, for exclusive use of the scholarship committee.
